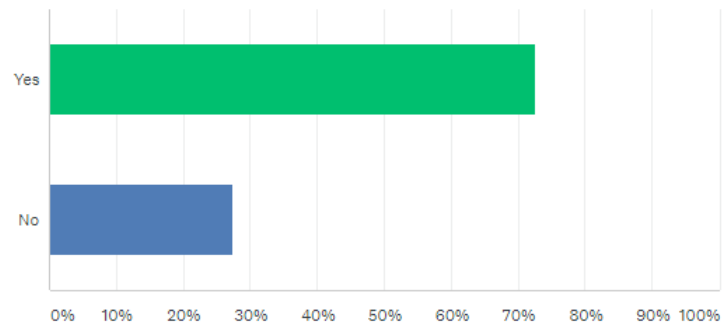

In comparison with the first national lockdown do you feel the quality of home learning has improved?

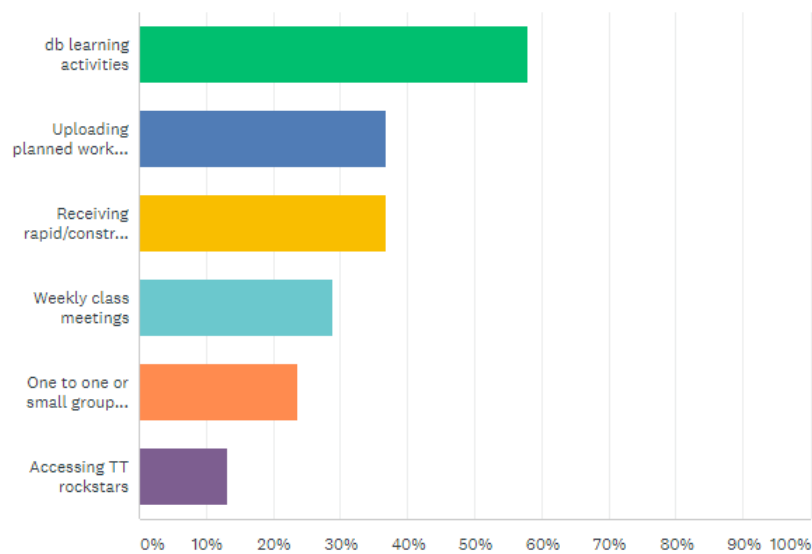
Answered: 40 Skipped: 0



School response – Almost 80% of parents surveyed felt the home learning had improved since the first lockdown.

Which of the following activities is your child enjoying and engaging well with?

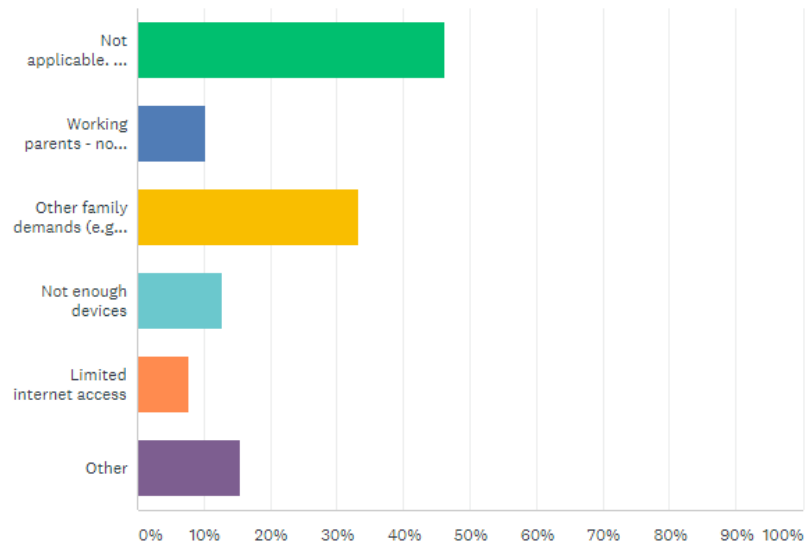
Answered: 38 Skipped: 2



School response – Pupils are engaging in a wide range of online learning.

What (if anything) is preventing your child from fully engaging with home learning

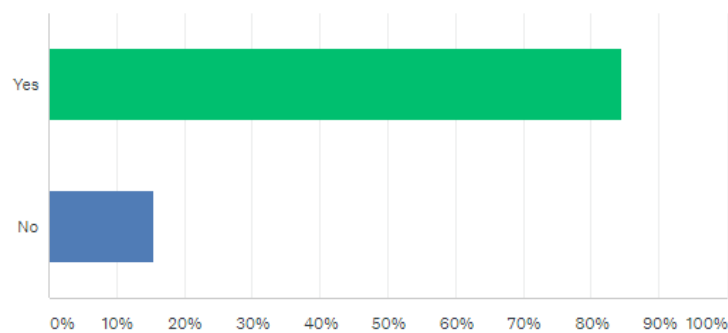
Answered: 39 Skipped: 1



School response – The largest barrier in preventing pupils engage in online learning was ‘other family demands’. Some parents shared this was particularly challenging when they have with more than one child in school. School responded to this by reaching out to those children with siblings to support them during the day and having regular ‘check ins’ via messaging on DB learning.

Is your child able to to the work the teacher has set and does it challenge them?

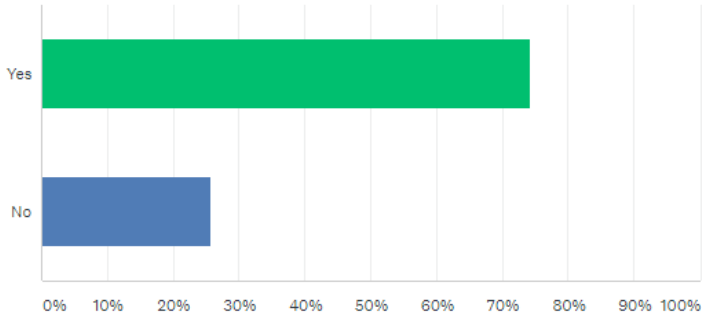
Answered: 39 Skipped: 1



School response – 85% of parents’ felt the work set met their child’s needs and challenged them.

Do you have all of the equipment you need to support your child with home learning activities?

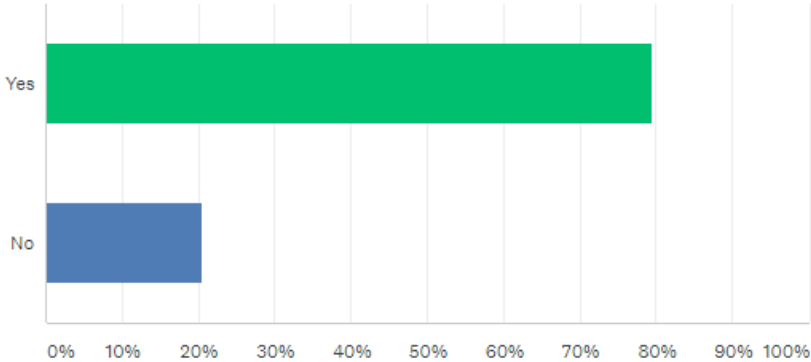
Answered: 39 Skipped: 1



School response – Extra equipment and resources were hand delivered to children who needed them as a result of this survey.

Do you feel school is supporting your child with their online work?

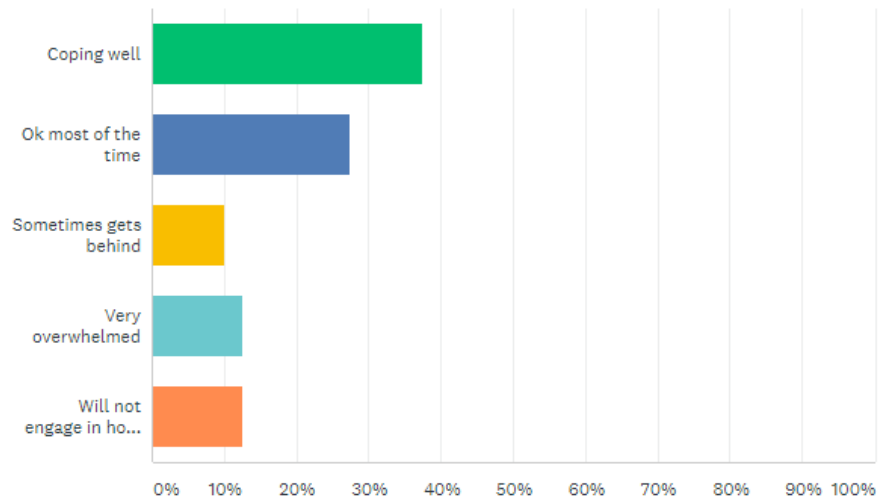
Answered: 39 Skipped: 1



School response –80% of parents’ felt their child was being supported whilst working from home.

Is your child coping with their work load?

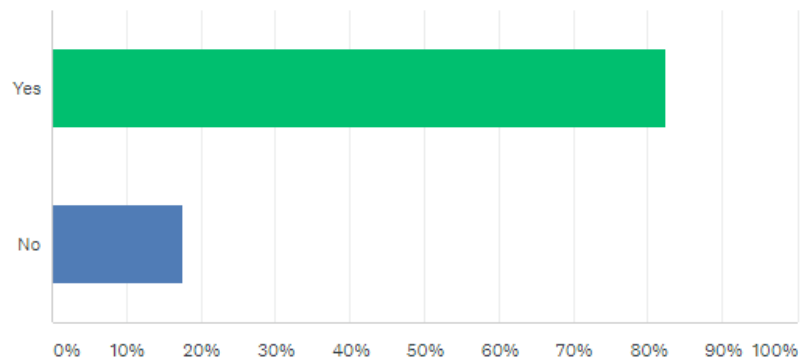
Answered: 40 Skipped: 0



School response – Almost 70% of parents felt that on the whole their child(ren) were coping with their online learning. Fewer than 10% would not engage at all. These children were encouraged by staff and never given up on. Weekly calls were carried out to ensure contact was made and pupils wellbeing was paramount.
