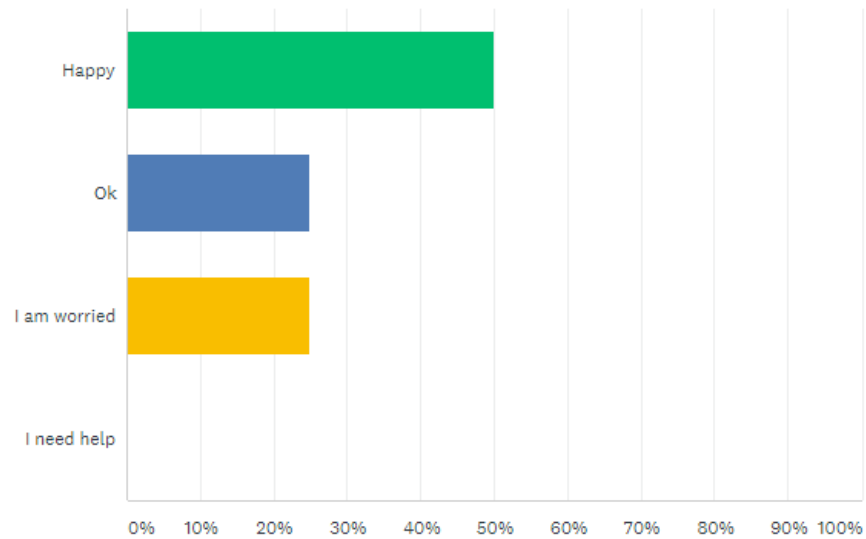


SEND Survey – Pupils in School during Lockdown 2021

How are you feeling during lockdown?

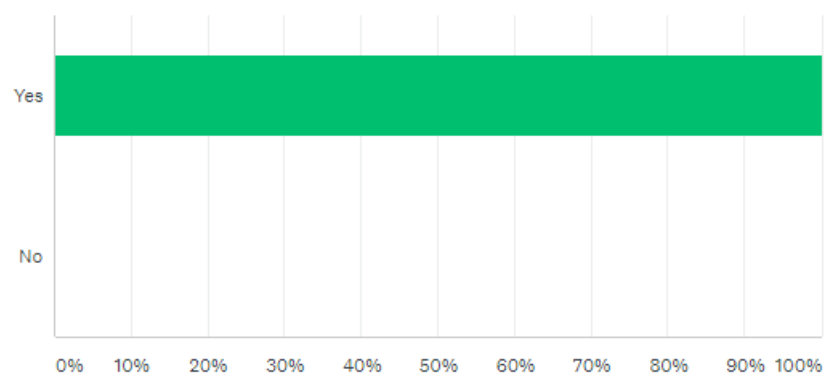
Answered: 8 Skipped: 0

I feel happy and safe coming to school

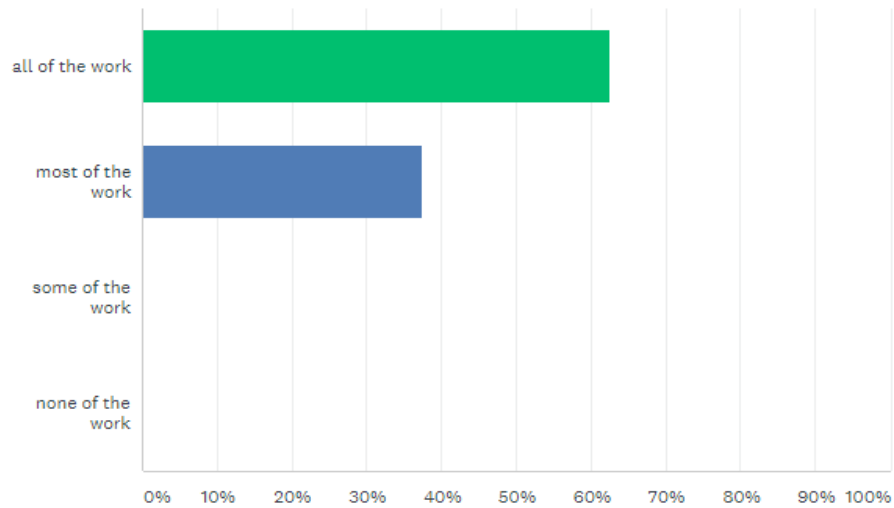
Answered: 8 Skipped: 0

I am enjoying doing the 'home learning' in school and I do...

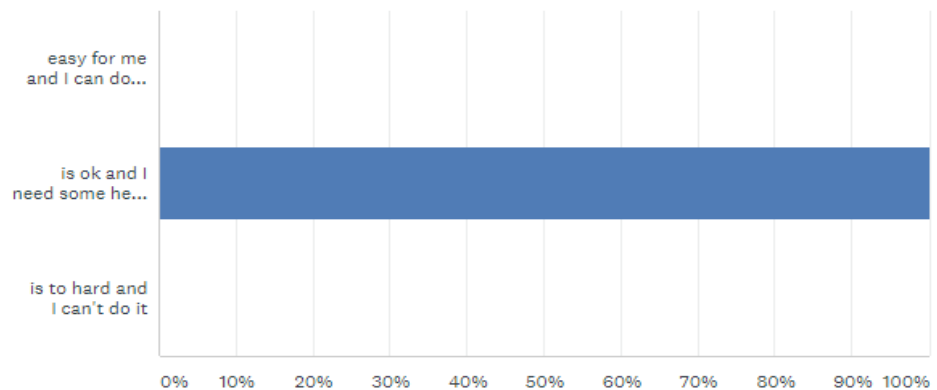

The work that my teacher gives me is...

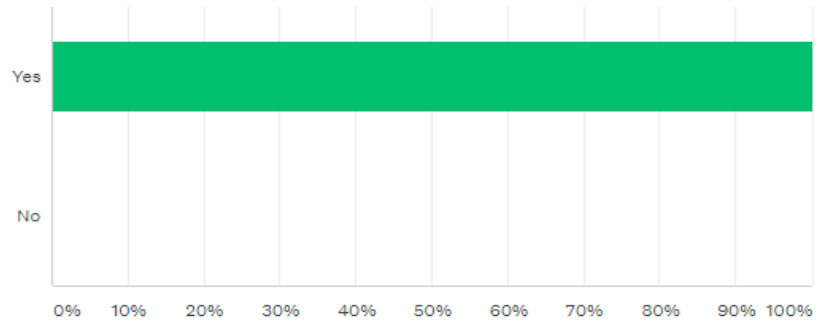
Answered: 8 Skipped: 0

I have found the feedback from my teachers helpful.

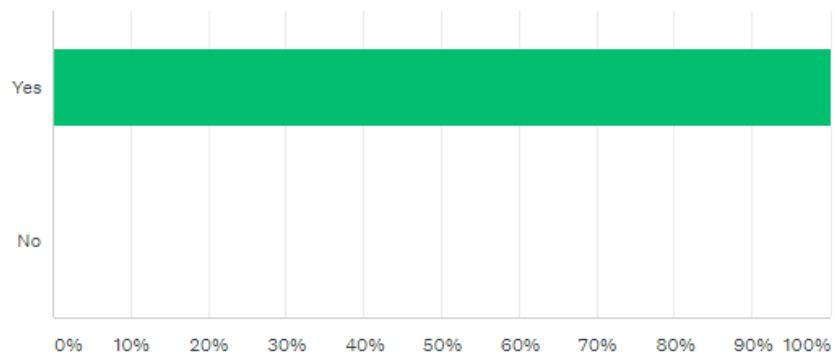

I am making good progress in school despite the lockdown.

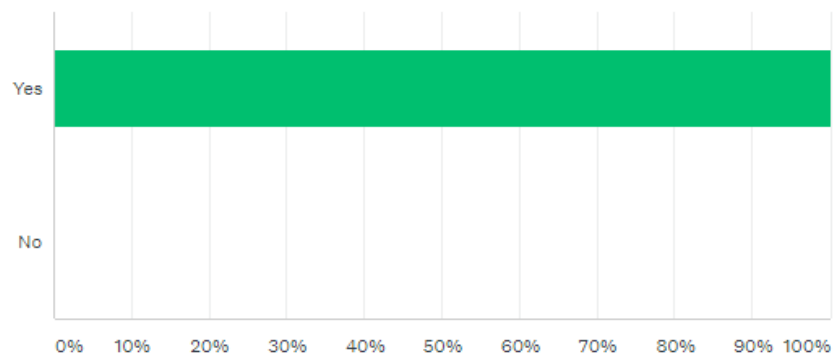

I can talk to my teachers about things that are worrying me.

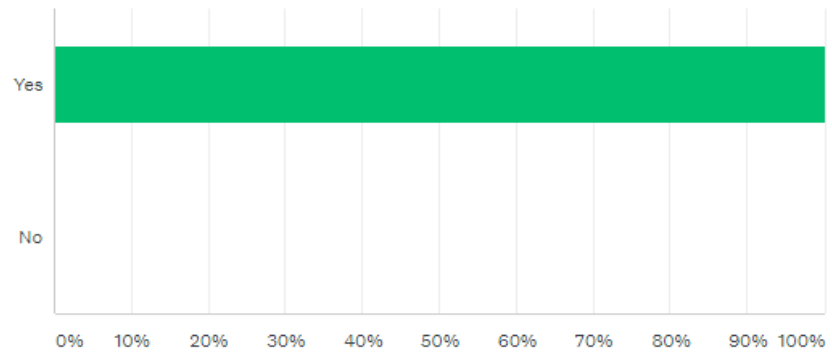
