

## Year 1 Vocabulary, Grammar & Punctuation Statutory Guidelines

<b>Word</b>	<b>Regular plural noun suffixes –s or –es</b> [for example, <i>dog, dogs; wish, wishes</i> ], including the effects of these suffixes on the meaning of the noun <b>Suffixes that can be added to verbs where no change is needed in the spelling of root</b> words (e.g. <i>helping, helped, helper</i> ) How the <b>prefix un–</b> changes the meaning of verbs and adjectives [negation, for example, <i>unkind</i> , or <i>undoing: untie the boat</i> ]
<b>Sentence</b>	How <b>words</b> can combine to make <b>sentences</b> <b>Joining words</b> and joining <b>clauses</b> using <b>and</b>
<b>Text</b>	Sequencing <b>sentences</b> to form short narratives
<b>Punctuation</b>	Separation of <b>words</b> with spaces <b>Introduction to capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks to demarcate sentences</b> <b>Capital letters for names and for the personal pronoun I</b>
<b>Terminology for Pupils</b>	<b><i>letter, capital letter, word, singular, plural, sentence, punctuation, full stop, question mark, exclamation mark</i></b>
